Directions to the Learning and Development Centre

From the M62, leave at junction 24. At Ainley Top roundabout, take the second exit (A629 Halifax) and continue on the dual carriage way. Follow signs to A&E turning left at the first traffic lights at Dudwell Lane, and then turn right onto Godfrey Road. The Learning and Development Centre is situated on your right as you enter into A&E Car park – see Area Q on the map above.
